| STRENGTHS | The Executive has been open to dialogue with the press, at least during the first six months of government. It has held media conferences and its ministers have been accessible sources for journalists. |
| WEAKNESSES | The stark political division that prevents dialogue persists in the media and journalist ecosystem, making the defense of the right to freedom of expression often seen as a mere politically motivated attack against the government and therefore loses momentum. |
| OPPORTUNITIES | Civil society organizations in general, media and journalists in particular are very alert to attempts by different branches of the national government to violate freedom of expression. Different organizations monitor the guarantees of this right in the country and are vigilant to these situations. |
| THREATS | The Executive has introduced a draft reform that may put the remaining independence of the Judiciary at risk, which could negatively affect freedom of expression. |
